Tuesday, October 17: Today, we will walk the places the Apostle Paul walked in Thessaloniki, including the Agora where he preached and the walls where Jason's home was and where St. Paul also lived. We will also see St. George Church, the Galerius Arch, and the Basilica of St. Sophia and St. Demetrios before continuing Veria, where St Paul preached at the BEMA. We drive to Kalambaka.

Wednesday, October 18: Today we will visit Metéora, where we will ascend huge granite rocks to view architectural wonders that are over 700 years old. We visit a monastery with its church and museum containing priceless historic and religious treasures. We drive to DELPHI.

Itineraries: Itineraries are prepared and scheduled in advance according to the best information available at the time and are subject to change by the date of the pilgrimage.

Pricing: Canterbury Pilgrimages & Tours Inc. reserves the right to adjust pricing should the following occur; (1) Rise in Airfare due to higher fuel costs, etc. (2) Rise in ground costs due to increases in hotel charges, bus fares, fees, taxes and other costs due to the fluctuating value of the U.S. dollar against foreign currency.

Deposits and Payments: A deposit of \$450 per person is required to hold your reservation of which \$200 is non-refundable (may be refundable under travel insurance conditions). Payment can be made by credit card or check. Call (800) 653-0017 to make a credit card payment.

Final payments: Final payment is due 75 days prior to the original departure date except in the case of postponement. The original departure date is a date of departure for which a new reservation is intended. In the event of postponement, if the decision of postponement is made sooner than 75 days prior to the original departure date, final payment will be due 75 days prior to the new departure date.
