October 27: We will take our bus from Sacramento to the San Francisco airport. Flight from San Francisco to Dubrovnik, Croatia, overnight trip.

October 28: Transfer from the airport to the hotel in Medjugorje, evening prayer program in the church, dinner and overnight at the hotel. While in Medjugorje, you will have the opportunity to deepen your faith and share in the spiritual journey of pilgrims from around the world.

October 29: Breakfast at the hotel, guided tour of the Hill of Apparitions where the visionaries met Our Lady for the first time. At the base of this hill is Cruz Azul where Our Lady appeared to the children while they were hiding from the communist police in the early days of the apparitions. We will visit the Cenacle community. This was founded by Sister Elvera Petrozzi in 1991 to support young people in recovery from addictions and teach them the way of life. Prayer program in the church. Dinner and accommodation at the hotel.

October 30: Breakfast at the hotel, guided visit to the mountain of La Cruz. It is a penitential climb that guides the pilgrim to reflect on their relationship with God and what they need to make a change in their lives to get closer to Him. Visit to the Mother's Village - the Community of the Franciscans of Herzegovina, an orphanage founded by Father Slavko Barbaric and is a visible fruit of Medjugorje. Prayer program in the church. Dinner and accommodation at the hotel.

October 31: After breakfast, you will have a guided walking tour of the Sanctuary and its surroundings. Visit of the church of Santiago, the statue of the Risen Christ - located in the grounds of the Church of Santiago.

This statue miraculously filters drops of water from the right knee of Christ. Visit to Sister Emmanuel-she is a religious of the Community of the Beatitudes and lives in Medjugorje, whose message she actively spreads throughout the world. Prayer program in the church. Dinner and accommodation at the hotel.

November 1: Breakfast at the hotel. The possibility of finding psychics if testimonials are available during the stay. Consecration to the Virgin in the community of the Beatitudes and visit to the Castle of Medjugorje. It is a retreat center built by Patrick and Nancy, free for visiting priests, nuns, seminarians and university students on pilgrimage to Medjugorje. Afternoon prayer program in the church.

November 2: Breakfast at the hotel. Excursion to the amazing natural wonder of the Kravica Waterfall, where you can take in the incredible views and maybe even take a dip in the refreshing waters of the river. Next, to Tihaljina, visit the Church of the Immaculate Conception of the Blessed Virgin Mary where we can celebrate Mass. Return to Medjugorje, dinner and overnight at the hotel.

November 3: Breakfast at the hotel. To Dubrovnik, known as the Pearl of the Adriatic. Upon arrival guided tour of one of the most beautiful cities in Europe – visit of the church of San Blas, Franciscan monastery with the oldest pharmacy in Europe, the Sponza palace, Onforio fountain etc. Afternoon free, we proceed to check in at the hotel and then share our farewell dinner.

November 4: Breakfast at the hotel, transfer to the airport. Continuing the way back home.

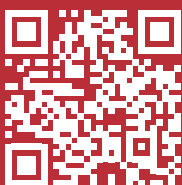

Terms of Service

Itineraries: Itineraries are prepared and scheduled in advance according to the best information available at the time and are subject to change by the date of the pilgrimage.

Pricing: Canterbury Pilgrimages & Tours Inc. reserves the right to adjust pricing should the following occur; (1) Rise in Airfare due to higher fuel costs, etc. (2) Rise in ground costs due to increases in hotel charges, bus fares, fees, taxes and other costs due to the fluctuating value of the U.S. dollar against foreign currency.

Deposits and Payments: A deposit of \$450 per person is required to hold your reservation of which \$200 is non-refundable (may be refundable under travel insurance conditions). Payment can be made by credit card or check. Call (800) 653-0017 to make a credit card payment.

Final payments: Final payment is due 75 days prior to the original departure date except in the case of postponement. The original departure date is a date of departure for which a new reservation is intended. In the event of postponement, if the decision of postponement is made sooner than 75 days prior to the original departure date, final payment will be due 75 days prior to the new departure date. If the decision of postponement is made 75 days prior to the original departure date or later then the payment remains due 75 days prior to the original departure date.

Cancellation fees: If the traveler's written notice of cancellation is received by Canterbury Pilgrimages & Tours Inc. more than 75 days prior to the original departure date all payments made toward the price of the tour will be refunded, less a \$200 processing fee. For cancellations received 75 days or less prior to the trip's departure, the initial deposit of \$450 plus any applicable charges imposed by the airlines, hotels, and bus companies on Canterbury Pilgrimages & Tours will be non-refundable. Please note that the amount may vary with each pilgrimage and the vendors we work with. In the event of postponement, the above still applies. Canterbury Pilgrimages & Tours Inc. retains the right to cancel any pilgrimage up to the departure date in which case all funds received will be returned within 10 business days.

The airlines for international flights will not allow a suitcase exceeding 50 pounds (subject to change), if over 50lbs., the fees can be costly. On inter-European flights, which are not directly connected to a transatlantic flight the baggage weight limit is lower. We will provide you with this information in the final travel documents. Baggage handling is not available on any of the trains.
