Tuesday, April 23 - Depart USAOur pilgrimage begins as we depart from the USA and begin our journey to Cairo.

Itineraries: Itineraries are prepared and scheduled in advance according to the best information available at the time and are subject to change by the date of the pilgrimage

Pricing: Canterbury Pilgrimages & Tours Inc. reserves the right to adjust pricing should the following occur; (1) Rise in Airfare due to higher fuel costs, etc. (2) Rise in ground costs due to increases in hotel charges, bus fares, fees, taxes and other costs due to the fluctuating value of the U.S. dollar against foreign currency.

Deposits and Payments: A deposit of \$450 per person is required to hold your reservation of which \$200 is non-refundable (may be refundable under travel insurance conditions). Payment can be made by credit card or check. Call (800) 653-0017 to make a credit card payment.

Final payments: Final payment is due 75 days prior to the original departure date except in the case of postponement. The original departure date is a date of departure for which a new reservation is intended. In the event of postponement, if the decision of postponement is made sooner than 75 days prior to the original departure date, final payment will be due 75 days prior to the new departure date. If the decision of postponement is made 75 days prior to the original departure date or later then the payment remains due 75 days prior to the original departure date.

Cancellation fees: If the traveler's written notice of cancellation is received by Canterbury Pilgrimages & Tours Inc. more than 75 days prior to the original departure date all payments made toward the price of the tour will be refunded, less a \$200 processing fee.
