October 7, 2024 | Overnight Flight to Italy

Our pilgrimage to Italy begins as we board our motor coach from our Parish and transfer to Miami International Airport and an overnight flight to Venice, Italy. Enjoy meals and refreshments served on the plane.

October 8, 2024 | Arrival in Venice

Upon arrival, we will transfer via deluxe motor coach to our hotel in Venice, where we will check into the hotel. After a bit of rest, we make our way to Mass followed by a welcome dinner. Dinner. *Overnight in Venice.*

October 9, 2024 | Venice

Today we'll visit St. Mark's Square, Basilica, the Bridge of Sighs, and the Palace of the Doges will highlight our tour of this mystical city. After lunch we board our motor coach and drive to Florence. Dinner. *Overnight in Florence.*

October 10, 2024 | Florence - Assisi

After breakfast, we will visit the magnificent Franciscan church of Santa Croce with its beautiful facade, a burial place of nobles, including Michelangelo and Galileo. We'll continue through Republic Square to the Santa Maria del Fiore, a 13th century cathedral. Later in the afternoon, we depart for Assisi, upon arrival we'll visit St. Mary of the Angels, where St. Francis spent a significant part of his life. We will explore the Chapel Portiuncola, the rose bush, and the cave where the saint retreated for prayer. Dinner. *Overnight in Assisi.*

October 11, 2024 | Assisi

After breakfast, we will visit Assisi, starting with the Basilica of Saint Clare and the lower crypt, where we will pray before her incorrupt body. We will also have a chance to reflect before the San Damiano cross, through which Christ spoke to St. Francis, urging him to rebuild His Church. Our next stop is the Basilica of Saint Francis, where we will attend Mass and offer prayers before his tomb. We will also visit the tomb of Blessed Carlo Acutis. Dinner. *Overnight in Assisi.*

October 12, 2024 | Assisi & Spiritual Sites

After breakfast we will visit the town of Loreto and celebrate

Mass at the Basilica Della Santa Casa, housing The Holy House of Loreto. Continuing our journey, we will visit Lanciano, the site of the Eucharistic Miracle from the eighth century. Finally, we will head to San Giovanni Rotondo to visit the shrine of St. Padre Pio. Dinner. *Overnight in San Giovanni Rotondo.*

October 13, 2024 | Exploring St. Padre Pio's Life

Today is dedicated to the town where St. Padre Pio lived for most of his life. We will visit the church of Santa Maria Della Grazie, where the tomb of St. Padre Pio is located, and offer Mass. In the afternoon, we will visit the Sanctuary of Monte Sant'Angelo. Dinner. *Overnight in San Giovanni Rotondo.*

October 14, 2024 | Journey to Rome, Montecassino

All roads lead to Rome... We depart for Rome and enroute we will visit Montecassino, a beautiful town founded by Saint Benedict in 529. Upon arrival in Rome, we will enter the city by way of the Colosseum, Arch of Constantine and the Forum. Next, we'll check-in to our hotel and have some time at leisure before dinner. *Overnight in Rome.*

October 15, 2024 | Tour of Papal Basilicas

After breakfast, we will visit the Basilica of St. Paul Outside the Walls, the Church of St. Mary Major, and the Archbasilica of St. John Lateran. Here, we will have the opportunity to climb the Lateran Steps and attend Mass. After a short lunch break, we will travel to the Pontifical North American College for a private tour, offering stunning views of Rome. Dinner. *Overnight in Rome.*

October 16, 2024 | Day at the Vatican - Papal Audience

In the morning, we will head to Saint Peter's Square for the Papal general audience with Pope Francis (subject to the Pope's schedule). Afterward, we will have a private Mass nearby. Following a brief lunch break, we'll embark on a tour of the Vatican Museum, Sistine Chapel, Scavi tour (subject to availability), and St. Peter's Basilica. *Overnight in Rome.*

October 17, 2024 | Return home

With a renewed sense of pilgrimage, and an invigorated love of our Catholic faith, we transfer to the Rome Fiumicino Airport and board our return flight home.

Terms of Service

Itineraries: Itineraries are prepared and scheduled in advance according to the best information available at the time and are subject to change by the date of the pilgrimage.

Pricing: Canterbury Pilgrimages & Tours Inc. reserves the right to adjust pricing should the following occur; (1) Rise in Airfare due to higher fuel costs, etc. (2) Rise in ground costs due to increases in hotel charges, bus fares, fees, taxes and other costs due to the fluctuating value of the U.S. dollar against foreign currency.

Deposits and Payments: A deposit of \$450 per person is required to hold your reservation of which \$200 is non-refundable (may be refundable under travel insurance conditions). Payment can be made by credit card or check. Call (800) 653-0017 to make a credit card payment.

Final payments: Final payment is due 75 days prior to the original departure date except in the case of postponement. The original departure date is a date of departure for which a new reservation is intended. In the event of postponement, if the decision of postponement is made sooner than 75 days prior to the original departure date, final payment will be due 75 days prior to the new departure date. If the decision of postponement is made 75 days prior to the original departure date or later then the payment remains due 75 days prior to the original departure date.

Cancellation fees: For cancellations received less than 75 days prior to the original departure date (even in the case of postponement), the initial deposit of \$450 plus any non-recoverable expenses associated with your reservation incurred by CP will be non-refundable. These expenses may include, but are not limited to, charges imposed by the airlines, hotels, and bus companies, the cost of labor associated with the servicing of your reservation, and the costs assessed for the use of our reservation system, as determined or estimated by CP. Please note that the amount may vary with each trip and the vendors we work with. CP retains the exclusive right to cancel or postpone any trip up to the departure date. If a trip is cancelled by CP all funds received will be returned with-in 10 business days. If a trip is postponed by CP the cancellation fees enumerated above will remain in effect.

Baggage: Please follow the general rule of traveling light - If you cannot carry it do not bring it. Passengers are permitted one piece of luggage per person. Baggage handling is included for one suitcase per person only, whenever possible, in the cost of the pilgrimage. The airlines for international flights will not allow a suitcase exceeding 50 pounds (subject to change), if over 50lbs., the fees can be costly. On inter-European flights, which are not directly connected to a transatlantic flight the baggage weight limit is lower. We will provide you with this information in the final travel documents. Baggage handling is not available on any of the trains. Every effort will be made to handle luggage carefully, however Canterbury Pilgrimages & Tours Inc. will not assume any liability for lost or damaged luggage or items inside luggage carrier. (Travel insurance may apply)

Travel insurance: We strongly recommend the purchase of travel insurance (personal accident/illness/injury/trip cancellation/baggage insurance). Canterbury Pilgrimages & Tours Inc. disclaims responsibility for accidents, personal illness or injury, trip cancellations, or handling of baggage not under our control. All categories of insurance may be purchased from Canterbury as provided by Allianz Travel Insurance.

Not Included: Gratuities, room service, laundry, telephone calls, and all personal expenses.

Without limitations CPT is not liable for any direct, indirect, consequential, or incidental damage, injury, death, loss, accident, delay, inconvenience or irregularity of any kind which may be occasioned by reason of any act or omission beyond their control, including, without limitation any willful or negligent act, failure to act, breach of contract or violation of local law or regulation of any third party such as an airline, train, hotel, bus, taxi, van, local ground handler or guide, whether or not it uses the CPT name, financial default or insolvency of any supplier which is to, or does supply any goods or services for this trip. Regardless of the participation of persons listed in the tentative itinerary and schedule of speakers the pilgrimage tour will proceed as scheduled on the dates listed. By signing this form to participate in this pilgrimage tour, you agree that the terms of the cancellation penalty will be binding upon you regardless of whether persons listed in the tentative itinerary and schedule of speakers are able to participate. CPT will not be responsible for any loss incurred by traveler, including lost days of the scheduled tour, due to a cancelled flight or other means and modes of transportation. Please investigate purchasing travel insurance as recommended, to cover any type of loss associated with cancelled air or other transportation.
