## 📍 Itinerary (subject to change)

### Monday, April 22 | Departure

Our pilgrimage begins as we board our plane for an overnight flight to Florence.

### Tuesday, April 23 | Arrival in Florence

Upon arrival into Florence, we'll meet with our Canterbury Pilgrimage representative to transfer and check-in to the hotel. Overnight Florence.

### Wednesday, April 24 | Florence/Assisi

After breakfast, we will visit the magnificent Franciscan church of Santa Croce with its beautiful facade, a burial place of nobles, including Michelangelo and Galileo. We'll continue through Republic Square to the Santa Maria del Fiore, a 13th century cathedral. Later in the afternoon, we depart for Assisi. Overnight Assisi.

### Thursday, April 25 | Assisi

After breakfast, we will visit the quaint hilltop birthplace of St. Francis. After lunch at one of the trattorias in Assisi, we will proceed to the Church of St. Clare to view the Saint's body, barely corrupt since her death centuries ago. St. Clare was the foundress of the Order of Poor Clare's. Then on to the basilica of St. Francis, to view some of the saint's possessions and the many frescoes depicting his life. Mass is celebrated here. A quick bus ride to the lower village for dinner. Overnight Assisi.

### Friday, April 26 | Orvieto/Sorrento

We depart Assisi for the beautiful Amalfi Coast. En-route we will visit the gorgeous hilltop town of Orvieto. The town sits on a 1,000-foot high rock formation, poetically crowned by Italy's most renowned Gothic cathedral. We visit the famous Cathedral housing the corporeale of the Miracle of the Eucharist in Bolsena where we will celebrate Mass. Next, we continue south and arrive at Sorrento. This town offers stunning panoramic views of the bay of Naples, where you will marvel at the picturesque narrow streets, parks, and villas. Dinner. Overnight Sorrento.

### Saturday, April 27 | Capri/Positano

This morning we board a hydrofoil to visit the island of Capri, starting with the Blue Grotto. We will take a tour of Mount Solaro, Villa San Michele, and the Church of San Michele. Our pilgrimage continues to Positano. There we will visit St. Andrew's relics and the tomb of St. Philomena. Dinner. Overnight Sorrento.

### Sunday, April 28 | Pompeii/Montecassino/Rome

All roads lead to Rome. We continue to Pompeii, a city buried in the ashes of Mt. Vesuvius in 79 AD. We will also visit the Sanctuary of Our Lady of Pompeii. Next, we visit Montecassino, a beautiful town founded by Saint Benedict in 529. On to Rome. Dinner. Overnight Rome.

### Monday, April 29 | Rome/Basilicas

We visit the Basilica of St. Paul Outside the Walls, the burial place of St. Paul. In the afternoon we will visit the Patriarchal Basilica of St. Mary Major. We also visit Santa Pudenziana, one of the oldest churches in Rome, where St. Peter and St. Paul resided for a time. Finally, we visit Santa Prassede, a 9th-century basilica with glorious Byzantine mosaics. Dinner and evening at leisure. Overnight Rome.

### Tuesday, April 30 | Rome

We begin today with Mass at the Church of Santa Maria Ara Coeli. Next we will visit the Mamertine Prison where St. Peter and St. Paul were imprisoned. We also visit the remnants of the Roman Forum. After lunch we will visit the Church of San Clemente. Dinner, and a visit the Piazza Navona. There we will enjoy the beautiful Fountain of the Four Rivers while tasting some Italian Gelato. Overnight Rome.

### Wednesday, May 1 | Rome/Papal Audience

After breakfast, we're off to Saint Peter's Square for the Papal general audience with Pope Francis (subject to the Pope's schedule) followed by a private Mass nearby. Following a short lunch break, we'll tour the Vatican Museum, Sistine Chapel, and St. Peter's Basilica, including a Scavi Tour (subject to availability), taking us inside the ancient underground cemetery that houses St Peter's tomb. Dinner/overnight in Rome.

### Thursday, May 2 | Departure

With a renewed sense of pilgrimage and an invigorated love of our Catholic faith, we will board our plane for our return flight home.

## Terms of Service

**Itineraries:** Itineraries are prepared and scheduled in advance according to the best information available at the time and are subject to change by the date of the pilgrimage.

**Pricing:** Canterbury Pilgrimages & Tours Inc. reserves the right to adjust pricing should the following occur; (1) Rise in Airfare due to higher fuel costs, etc. (2) Rise in ground costs due to increases in hotel charges, bus fares, fees, taxes and other costs due to the fluctuating value of the U.S. dollar against foreign currency.

**Deposits and Payments:** A deposit of \$450 per person is required to hold your reservation of which \$200 is non-refundable (may be refundable under travel insurance conditions). Payment can be made by credit card or check. Call (800) 653-0017 to make a credit card payment.

**Final payments:** Final payment is due 75 days prior to the original departure date except in the case of postponement. The original departure date is a date of departure for which a new reservation is intended. In the event of postponement, if the decision of postponement is made sooner than 75 days prior to the original departure date, final payment will be due 75 days prior to the new departure date. If the decision of postponement is made 75 days prior to the original departure date or later then the payment remains due 75 days prior to the original departure date.

**Cancellation fees:** If the traveler's written notice of cancellation is received by Canterbury Pilgrimages & Tours Inc. more than 75 days prior to the original departure date all payments made toward the price of the tour will be refunded, less a \$200 processing fee. For cancellations received 75 days or less prior to the trip, departure, the initial deposit of \$450 plus any applicable charges imposed by the airlines, hotels, and bus companies on Canterbury Pilgrimages & Tours will be non-refundable. Please note that the amount may vary with each pilgrimage and the vendors we work with. In the event of postponement, the above still applies. Canterbury Pilgrimages & Tours Inc. retains the right to cancel any pilgrimage up to the departure date in which case all funds received will be returned within 10 business days.

**Baggage:** Please follow the general rule of traveling light - If you cannot carry it do not bring it. Passengers are permitted one piece of luggage per person. Baggage handling is included for one suitcase per person only, whenever possible, in the cost of the pilgrimage. The airlines for international flights will not allow a suitcase exceeding 50 pounds (subject to change), if over 50lbs., the fees can be costly. On inter-European flights, which are not directly connected to a transatlantic flight the baggage weight limit is lower. We will provide you with this information in the final travel documents. Baggage handling is not available on any of the trains. Every effort will be made to handle luggage carefully, however Canterbury Pilgrimages & Tours Inc. will not assume any liability for lost or damaged luggage or items inside luggage carrier. (Travel insurance may apply)

**Travel insurance:** We strongly recommend the purchase of travel insurance (personal accident/illness/injury/trip cancellation/baggage insurance). Canterbury Pilgrimages & Tours Inc. disclaims responsibility for accidents, personal illness or injury, trip cancellations, or handling of baggage not under our control. All categories of insurance may be purchased from Canterbury as provided by Allianz Travel Insurance.

**Not Included:** Gratuities, room service, laundry, telephone calls, and all personal expenses.

Regardless of the participation of persons listed in the tentative itinerary and schedule of speakers the pilgrimage tour will proceed as scheduled on the dates listed. By signing this form to participate in this pilgrimage tour, you agree that the terms of the cancellation penalty will be binding upon you regardless of whether persons listed in the tentative itinerary and schedule of speakers are able to participate. CPT will not be responsible for any loss incurred by traveler, including lost days of the scheduled tour, due to a cancelled flight or other means and modes of transportation. Please investigate purchasing travel insurance as recommended, to cover any type of loss associated with cancelled air or other transportation.
