Monday June 24, 2024 | Depart USA LAX to London Today we depart Los Angeles for our overnight flight to London, England.

Tuesday June 25, 2024 | Arrival in London Welcome to London, England! Upon your arrival, you will collect your luggage and meet with the guide and driver who will accompany the group throughout your stay. Tour of London by night.

Wednesday June 26, 2024 | London Today we begin with a panoramic tour of London; including historical landmarks like Big Ben, the London Eye, Buckingham Palace, Piccadilly Square, Regent Street, and Trafalgar Square, Westminster Abbey. Feel immersed in British culture as you explore the city on a guided tour. Private Mass at St. Etheldreda's Church in Ely Place. This church is the oldest Catholic Church in England and served as a safe-haven for Catholics who continued to celebrate the Mass despite the Catholic persecution in the 17th century. At this church you will find the shrine to St. Etheldreda, an incorrupt saint, who lived a life of austerity and saved many through her powerful intercessions from Heaven. Dinner and overnight in London

Thursday June 27, 2024 | London This morning we go to Rochester, home of St. John Fisher. John Fisher was the only Bishop in England to oppose King Henry VIII. We visit the chapel built to honor St. John Fisher. Next we drive to Canterbury to see the Cathedral where Archbishop Thomas Beckett was martyred at the hands of King Henry II in 1170. The history of Canterbury dates to the time of St. Augustine who brought Christianity to England in 597. We visit Canterbury Cathedral, Mother Church of the worldwide Anglican Communion. Next we visit St. Augustine Monastery and see its Oratory of Our Lady. Dinner and overnight in London

Friday June 28, 2024 | London to Venice Transfer to the airport for your flight to Italy. (EasyJet has a 5:55 am to VCE) Upon arrival, we will be transferred to Tronchetto Bus Area where you'll catch your motor boat to Piazza San Marco. Once arrived, your guide will wait in the Square for start your walking tour. During our tour, we will see such landmark sites as Doge's Palace (not entrance) and the Bridge of Sighs. Then we'll visit St. Mark's Square, one of the most distinguished creations of medieval architecture and symbol of the ancient Venetian Republic, which contains the tomb of Saint Mark the Evangelist, patron saint of Venice. Famous Gondola ride through the water ways of Venice. (time permitting). **Note flight from London is schedule to arrive at 9 am. However, if the flights get delayed or change we may not have enough time to complete all scheduled activities. Dinner and overnight at the hotel in Venice.

Saturday June 29, 2024 | Venice – Milan Breakfast at the hotel. Am departure to Milan. Today city tour of Milan, during the visit we will visit the famous Duomo, a magnificent Cathedral, then we will walk in the Galleria Vittorio Emanuele II. We will continue with some of the other churches of Milan (program to be determined). Free time for shopping. Dinner and overnight at the hotel in Milan.

Sunday June 30, 2024 | Milan – Pisa – Florence Breakfast at the hotel and checkout. In the morning departure from Milan to Pisa. Here we will have free time to explore the famous Piazza dei miracoli on your own. All the most important sites are in this square. You can finally admire the Leaning Tower, the Baptistery and the Cathedral, (entrances included). Dinner and overnight at the hotel in Florence.

Monday July 1, 2024 | Florence – Assisi Breakfast at the hotel and checkout. Today we enjoy a guided tour of Florence's main sights, including the Cathedral with its magnificent

Dome by Brunelleschi, Giotto's elegant belfry and the Baptistery with Ghiberti's Gate to Paradise. We also visit the Basilica di Santa Croce, where we will see the tombs of several famous people, including Michelangelo, Galileo & Machiavelli. Free time for lunch (not included). At accorded time, transfer to our hotel in Assisi check in and accommodation. Dinner and overnight at the hotel in Assisi.

Tuesday July 2, 2024 | Assisi – San Giovanni Rotondo Breakfast at the hotel. In the morning, we'll visit St. Mary of the Angels, where St. Francis spent a significant part of his life. We will explore the Chapel Porziuncola, the rose bush, and the cave where the saint retreated for prayer. Then, continue with the visit at the Basilica of Saint Clare and the lower crypt, where we will pray before her incorrupt body. Our next stop is the Basilica of Saint Francis. Lunch free not included At accorded time transfer depart for our transfer to San Giovanni Rotondo. Dinner and overnight at the hotel in San Giovanni Rotondo.

Wednesday July 3, 2024 | San Giovanni Rotondo – Naples Breakfast at the hotel and checkout. Today is dedicated to the town where St. Padre Pio lived for most of his life. We will visit the church of Santa Maria Della Grazie, where the tomb of St. Padre Pio is located, we'll continue to the Sanctuary of Monte Sant'Angelo. In the afternoon, we depart San Giovanni Rotondo and head Naples. Dinner and overnight in Naples.

Thursday July 4, 2024 | Naples – Pompeii – Rome Breakfast at the hotel. Today we start with a panoramic tour of Naples. After the panoramic city tour, transfer to Pompeii and visit with the Guide the ruins of this ancient city. Free time for lunch (not included). At the end of the tour transfer back to Rome.

Friday July 5, 2024 | Rome Breakfast at the hotel. Today we start our tour of the Papal Basilicas. We will visit the Basilica of St. Paul Outside the Walls, the Church of St. Mary Major, the most important church in the world devoted to Our Lady. Here we celebrate Mass where Mass has been celebrated every day since the 5th century. While at St. Mary's we enjoy some free time for prayer and further exploration of this wonderful basilica. Then, continue with the Archbasilica of St. John Lateran, the Pope's cathedral church where relics of both Peter and Paul remain under the main altar. Here we will see its impressive statues of each of the Apostles. From here we cross the street to visit the church of the Scala Santa. Here we see the Holy Staircase of 28 marble steps (now covered in wood) which is believed to be a staircase from Pilate's palace in Jerusalem and brought to Rome by Saint Helen in the 4th century. Free time for lunch (not included). Dinner and Overnight in Rome.

Saturday July 6, 2024 | Rome – Vatican City Early Breakfast (or box breakfast) at the hotel. Transfer to St. Peter square in order to celebrate a Mass in St. Peter (availability to be reconfirmed). Following the Mass, we will visit with our guide the Basilica, followed by a visit to the Tombs of the Popes in the Vatican Grottos. Then we'll embark on a tour of the Vatican Museum, Sistine Chapel. Free time for lunch (not included). We continue our tour to Capitoline Hill, where we will enjoy a view of the ancient Roman Forum and see Constantine's Arch, the Arch of Titus, the Circus Maximus and ancient Roman Aqueducts. Following a guided tour of the world-famous Colosseum (inside) and ancient Roman Forum. Next we take a walking tour through the Baroque Rome, with Trevi Fountain and Spanish Steps, Piazza Navona and the Pantheon. Farewell dinner in a local restaurant "LA CAROVANA" (according with their availability). After the dinner transfer back to the hotel for overnight.

Sunday July 7, 2024 | Return Home. With a renewed sense of pilgrimage, and an invigorated love of our Catholic faith, we transfer to the Rome Fiumicino Airport and board our return flight home.

Terms of Service

Itineraries: Itineraries are prepared and scheduled in advance according to the best information available at the time and are subject to change by the date of the pilgrimage.

Pricing: Canterbury Pilgrimages & Tours Inc. reserves the right to adjust pricing should the following occur; (1) Rise in Airfare due to higher fuel costs, etc. (2) Rise in ground costs due to increases in hotel charges, bus fares, fees, taxes and other costs due to the fluctuating value of the U.S. dollar against foreign currency.

Deposits and Payments: A deposit of \$450 per person is required to hold your reservation of which \$200 is non-refundable (may be refundable under travel insurance conditions). Payment can be made by credit card or check. Call (800) 653-0017 to make a credit card payment.

Final payments: Final payment is due 75 days prior to the original departure date except in the case of postponement. The original departure date is a date of departure for which a new reservation is intended. In the event of postponement, if the decision of postponement is made sooner than 75 days prior to the original departure date, final payment will be due 75 days prior to the new departure date. If the decision of postponement is made 75 days prior to the original departure date or later then the payment remains due 75 days prior to the original departure date.

Cancellation fees: If the traveler's written notice of cancellation is received by Canterbury Pilgrimages & Tours Inc. more than 75 days prior to the original departure date all payments made toward the price of the tour will be refunded, less a \$200 processing fee. For cancellations received 75 days or less prior to the trip; departure, the initial deposit of \$450 plus any applicable charges imposed by the airlines, hotels, and bus companies on Canterbury Pilgrimages & Tours will be non-refundable. Please note that the amount may vary with each pilgrimage and the vendors we work with. In the event of postponement, the above still applies. Canterbury Pilgrimages & Tours Inc. retains the right to cancel any pilgrimage up to the departure date in which case all funds received will be returned within 10 business days.

Baggage: Please follow the general rule of traveling light - If you cannot carry it do not bring it. Passengers are permitted one piece of luggage per person. Baggage handling is included for one suitcase per person only, whenever possible, in the cost of the pilgrimage. The airlines for international flights will not allow a suitcase exceeding 50 pounds (subject to change), if over 50lbs., the fees can be costly. On inter-European flights, which are not directly connected to a transatlantic flight the baggage weight limit is lower. We will provide you with this information in the final travel documents. Baggage handling is not available on any of the trains. Every effort will be made to handle luggage carefully, however Canterbury Pilgrimages & Tours Inc. will not assume any liability for lost or damaged luggage or items inside luggage carrier. (Travel insurance may apply)

Travel insurance: We strongly recommend the purchase of travel insurance (personal accident/illness/injury/trip cancellation/baggage insurance). Canterbury Pilgrimages & Tours Inc. disclaims responsibility for accidents, personal illness or injury, trip cancellations, or handling of baggage not under our control.
