October 13 - 23, 2025

Day 1: Monday, October 13, 2025 | Depart for Lisbon

Our pilgrimage begins today as we board our overnight flight(s) from Portland to Lisbon, Portugal.

Day 2: Tuesday, October 14 | St. Anthony of Padua

Upon arrival in Lisbon, we'll visit the birthplace of St. Anthony of Padua in Lisbon and further north we'll visit St. Stephen's Church in Santarem and adore the miracle of the "Bleeding Host." Afternoon arrival into Fátima. Tonight, we'll all head to the shrine for the candlelight procession. Overnight in Fátima, Portugal. D.

Day 3: Wednesday October 15 | Capelinha, Aljustrel, Valinhos

We enjoy Mass this morning at the Capelinha built over the holm oak tree where Our Lady appeared five times to the three shepherd children Lucia, Jacinta, and Francisco. We'll tour the basilica and shrine. This afternoon, we'll visit Aljustrel where the angel of Portugal appeared, and Valinhos where Our Lady appeared in 1917. Tonight, we'll all head to the shrine for the candlelight procession. Overnight in Fátima, Portugal. B, D.

Day 4: Thursday, October 16 | Journey to Lourdes

This morning we depart Fatima and drive to Porto; we will have some time in Porto before we board our flight to Toulouse. Afternoon arrival into Toulouse, then we will collect our bags and transfer to Lourdes. This afternoon, we will have time to relax our explores Lourdes on our own. In the evening, we will gather for the candlelight procession. Overnight in Lourdes, France. B, D.

Day 5: Friday, October 17 | Our Lady of Lourdes

Today we visit the Sanctuary of Our Lady of Lourdes, the Cave of Apparitions, the Basilicas, and the House of St. Bernadette. In the afternoon we'll have free time to participate in the ceremonies of the Sanctuary and bathe in the miraculous waters. After dinner, we participate in the Candlelight Rosary Procession. Overnight in Lourdes, France. B, D.

Day 6: Saturday, October 18 | Journey to Rome

Following morning Mass, we bid farewell to Our Lady, but with the consolation that she is always with us as we continue our pilgrim way, for no pilgrim ever leaves Lourdes untouched by Mary. We are off to Rome by flight. Upon arrival in Rome, we will take a "get yourself acquainted tour" of the Eternal City. Later we will check into our hotel. Overnight in Rome, Italy. B, D.

Day 7: Sunday, October 19 | Assisi & Blessed Carlo Acutis

After breakfast, we begin our day trip to Assisi. Our first visit will be St. Mary of the Angels, where St. Francis spent a significant part of his life. We will explore the Chapel Portiuncola, the rose bush, and the cave where the saint retreated for prayer. Next, we will proceed to the Church of St. Clare to view the Saint's body, incorrupt since her death centuries ago. We will have some free time for lunch at Piazza del Comune followed by a visit to St. Mary Major. We will also visit the Basilica of St. Francis where Father will celebrate Mass. Finally, we will take time to visit the Shrine of the Renunciation, where the millennial saint Blessed Carlo Acutis' body is interred. We'll return to Rome for dinner and an overnight. Overnight in Rome, Italy. B, D.

Day 8: Monday, October 20 | Major Roman Basilicas

Today we will visit and have an opportunity to walk through the Holy Doors at the Basilica of St. Paul Outside the Walls, the Basilica of St. Mary Major, and the Archbasilica of St. John Lateran. Those who pass through a Holy Door can also receive a plenary indulgence. At the Archbasilica of St. John Lateran, we also will have the opportunity to climb the Lateran Steps and Celebrate Holy Mass. Overnight in Rome, Italy. B, D.

Day 9: Tuesday, October 21 | Exploring Ancient Rome

After breakfast, we will embark on a tour of Ancient Rome. We will visit the Colosseum, a grand amphitheater of the ancient world. Along the way we'll stop for prayer at the Basilica of Saint Clement. Passing by the Roman Forum, we will witness the ruins of ancient government buildings. We'll finish the day visiting the Catacombs of St. Callixtus, a resting place of several popes from the 2nd t4th centuries. Overnight in Rome, Italy. B, D.

Day 10: Wednesday, October 22 | Vatican City

In the morning, we head to Saint Peter's Square for the Papal general audience with Pope Francis (subject to his schedule). Afterward, we will have a private Mass nearby. Following a brief lunch, we tour the Vatican Museum, Sistine Chapel, and St. Peter's Basilica. We will be able to walk through the Holy Door at St. Peters Basilica. We will gather in the evening for our farewell dinner at a local restaurant. Overnight in Rome, Italy. B, D.

Day 11: Thursday, October 23, 2025 | Return Home

With a renewed sense of pilgrimage, and an invigorated love of our Catholic faith, we transfer to the Rome Fiumicino Airport and board our return flight home.

Itineraries: Itineraries are prepared and scheduled in advance according to the best information available at the time and are subject to change by the date of the pilgrimage.

Pricing: Canterbury Pilgrimages & Tours Inc. reserves the right to adjust pricing should the following occur; (1) Rise in Airfare due to higher fuel costs, etc. (2) Rise in ground costs due to increases in hotel charges, bus fares, fees, taxes and other costs due to the fluctuating value of the U.S. dollar against foreign currency.

Deposits and Payments: A deposit of \$450 per person is required to hold your reservation of which \$200 is nonrefundable (may be refundable under travel insurance conditions). Payment can be made by credit card or check. Call (800) 653-0017 to make a credit card payment.

Final payments: Final payment is due 90 days prior to the original departure date except in the case of postponement. The original departure date is a date of departure for which a new reservation is intended. In the event of postponement, if the decision of postponement is made sooner than 90 days prior to the original departure date, final payment will be due 90 days prior to the new departure date. If the decision of postponement is made 90 days prior to the original departure date or later then the payment remains due 90 days prior to the original departure date.

Cancellation fees: If the traveler's written notice of cancellation is received by Canterbury Pilgrimages & Tours Inc. more than 90 days prior to the original departure date all payments made toward the price of the tour will be refunded, less a \$200 processing fee. For cancellations received 90 days or less prior to the trip,' departure, the initial deposit of \$450 plus any applicable charges imposed by the airlines, hotels, and bus companies on Canterbury Pilgrimages & Tours will be non-refundable. Please note that the amount may vary with each pilgrimage and the vendors we work with. In the event of postponement, the above still applies. Canterbury Pilgrimages & Tours Inc. retains the right to cancel any pilgrimage up to the departure date in which case all funds received will be returned within 10 business days.

Baggage handling is not available on any of the trains.
