Canterbury Pilgrimages

Day 1: Depart Mobile to Buffalo, Niagara Falls, NY

We depart from Mobile and fly to Buffalo, NY. Upon arrival, we meet our tour escort and transfer to Niagara Falls NY. After checking into our hotel, we gather for dinner and begin our pilgrimage together. Overnight in Niagara Falls NY. (D)

Day 2: Shrine of Our Lady of Fatima Canadian Side of Niagara Falls - Boat Tour

After breakfast, we visit the National Shrine of Our Lady of Fatima for prayer and reflection. We then cross into Canada to view the magnificent Niagara Falls from the Canadian side, followed by a boat tour that brings us close to the base of the falls. We return to our hotel for dinner and rest. Overnight in Niagara Falls NY. (B, D)

Day 3: Our Lady of Victory - Shrine of Our Lady of the Martyrs

This morning we travel to Our Lady of Victory Basilica in Lackawanna, founded by Venerable Nelson Baker. In the afternoon, we continue to Auriesville to visit the Shrine of Our Lady of the Martyrs, honoring Saints Isaac Jogues, Rene Goupil, and John LaLande. We spend time on these sacred grounds in prayer. Overnight in Auriesville. (B, D)

Day 4: National Shrine of Divine Mercy - Return to Auriesville

Today we visit the National Shrine of Divine Mercy in Stockbridge MA. We pray at the Shrine Church, walk the Life sized Stations of the Cross, and spend time at devotional sites including the Holy Family Shrine, the Lourdes Grotto, the Shrine of the Holy Innocents, and the Immaculate Conception Candle Shrine. We return to Auriesville for dinner. Overnight in Auriesville. (B, D)

Day 5: Drive to Montreal - Notre Dame de Bon Secours Chapel

This morning we depart Auriesville and travel north toward Canada, enjoying a scenic drive through Vermonts rolling hills and colorful autumn foliage. In early October, the countryside is covered in brilliant fall colors, creating one of the most picturesque drives of the season. Upon arrival in Montreal, we visit the historic Notre Dame de Bon Secours Chapel, also known as the Sailors Chapel. Afterward, we check into our hotel and gather for dinner. Overnight in Montreal. (B, D)

Day 6: St. Josephs Oratory - Marguerite Bourgeays Museum - Basilica Marie Reine du Monde

After breakfast, we visit St Josephs Oratory, founded by Saint Andre Bessette and known for healings through the

intercession of Saint Joseph. We continue with a visit to the Marguerite Bourgeays Museum before concluding our day at Basilica Marie Reine du Monde. We return to our hotel for dinner. Overnight in Montreal. (B, D)

Day 7: Kahnawake - Notre Dame Basilica - Travel to Quebec City

After breakfast, we travel to Kahnawake to visit the burial place of Saint Kateri Tekakwitha, the first Native American saint. We take a few quiet moments here in prayer before returning to Montreal. Next, we visit Notre Dame Basilica, known for its striking Gothic interior and rich Catholic heritage. After Mass, we begin our drive to Quebec City, where we check in, enjoy dinner, and rest for the evening. Overnight in Quebec City. (B, D)

Day 8: Old Quebec City Basilica Cathedral Notre Dame de Quebec - Catholic Heritage Sites

This morning we explore Old Quebec City, a UNESCO World Heritage site filled with historic churches, early missionary history, and centuries of Catholic tradition. We visit Basilica Cathedral Notre Dame de Quebec, home to the only Holy Door in North America, and the historic crypt. Our day continues with visits to the Francois de Laval Center, the Ursuline Monastery, the Marie de l'Incarnation Center, the Augustine Monastery, and the Catherine de Saint Augustine Center. We then enjoy free time along charming Rue du Petit Champlain before gathering for dinner. Overnight in Quebec City. (B, D)

Day 9: Montmorency Falls - Albert Gilles Copper Museum Sainte Anne de Beaupre

We begin our day with a visit to Montmorency Falls, which rise higher than Niagara Falls and offer beautiful views of the St Lawrence River. We continue to the Albert Gilles Copper Museum to learn about the traditional art of copper embossing, including religious works used in churches throughout the region. Next, we travel to the Basilica of Sainte Anne de Beaupre, one of the most visited pilgrimage sites in North America. We explore its chapels, mosaics, stained glass, sculptures, and the St Anne Museum, and celebrate Mass on the shrine grounds. We return to Quebec City for our farewell dinner and final overnight. Overnight in Quebec City. (B, D)

Day 10: Return Home

After breakfast we transfer to the airport for our flights home, grateful for the blessings of our pilgrimage. (B)
