**Day 1: September 1st, 2026**

*Our Pilgrimage Begins*

We begin our pilgrimage today as we depart from our local airports on an overnight flight(s) to Dublin, Ireland. Meals and drinks will be served on board.

**Day 2: September 2nd, 2026**

*Arrival in Dublin*

Upon arrival in Dublin, one of Europe's most vibrant capitals, we transfer to our hotel and settle in. In the evening, we celebrate our Welcome Mass together (subject to our arrival times), followed by our welcome dinner. Overnight in Dublin.

**Day 3: September 3rd, 2026**

*Glendalough, Monasterevin, Limerick*

After breakfast, we travel through the scenic Wicklow Mountains to Glendalough, a 6th-century monastic site founded by St. Kevin. We'll visit the Round Tower, St. Kevin's Kitchen, and the cathedral ruins surrounded by an incredible valley. After lunch, we journey toward Limerick, stopping in Monasterevin to celebrate Mass at St. Peter and Paul's Church. Dinner and overnight in Limerick.

**Day 4: September 4th, 2026**

*Glenstal Abbey, Rock of Cashel, King John's Castle*

This morning, we visit Glenstal Abbey, a Benedictine monastery dedicated to St. Joseph and St. Columba. Next, we travel to the iconic Rock of Cashel to explore Cormac's Chapel (subject to availability) and St. Mary's Cathedral. We return to Limerick for a visit to King John's Castle and nearby St. Mary's Cathedral, founded in 1168—just a short walk apart. Dinner is not included tonight. Overnight in Limerick. (Entrance tickets to Cormac's Chapel are only available to purchase on site on a first come first serve basis)

**Day 5: September 5th, 2026**

*Blarney Castle & Cork City*

Today we depart for Blarney Castle, where we'll have

the opportunity to kiss the famous Blarney Stone and explore the castle grounds. After lunch and shopping at Blarney Woolen Mills, we'll continue to Cork City to celebrate Mass and visit St. Fin Barre's Cathedral, dedicated to Cork's patron saint. Dinner and overnight in Cork.

**Day 6: September 6th, 2026**

*Dingle Peninsula, Gallarus Oratory, Kilmalkedar Church*

This morning, we travel along the breathtaking Dingle Peninsula, passing Eagle Mountain and Sleah Head. We visit the early Christian Gallarus Oratory and the 12th-century Kilmalkedar Church. After celebrating Mass and enjoying free time in Dingle, we continue to Killarney. Dinner and overnight in Killarney.

**Day 7: September 7th, 2026**

*Killimer Ferry, GAL, Corcomroe Abbey, Galway Cathedral*

Today we cross the Shannon Estuary by ferry from Tarbert to Killimer and drive along Ireland's rugged coast to the dramatic Cliffs of Moher. We then visit Corcomroe Abbey before ending the day at Galway Cathedral—the Cathedral of Our Lady Assumed into Heaven and St. Nicholas. Dinner is not included tonight. Overnight in Galway.

**Day 8: September 8th, 2026**

*Knock Shrine and Return to Dublin*

Today, we travel to Knock, Ireland's national Marian shrine. We'll spend time at the Knock Museum and Basilica, with Mass and time for quiet reflection. In the afternoon, we journey back to Dublin for our final evening. Farewell dinner and overnight in Dublin.

**Day 9: September 9th, 2026**

*Return Home*

After breakfast, we transfer to Dublin Airport for our return flight home - renewed in spirit and blessed by the sacred places we've visited and the community we've formed.
