# Shrines of Montreal Pilgrimage | July 20-24, 2026

## Day 1: Monday, July 20, 2026 | Tulsa - Montreal

Our pilgrimage begins today as we depart from Tulsa Airport for our flight to Montreal, Canada. Upon arrival, we will transfer by bus to our hotel for check-in. This afternoon, we will enjoy a walking tour of the city with Fr. Elkin and our local tour guide. Dinner this evening. Overnight in Montreal. (D)

## Day 2: Tuesday, July 21, 2026 | Saint Joseph's Oratory

After breakfast at the hotel, we will enjoy a guided visit to Saint Joseph's Oratory, the world's largest shrine dedicated to Saint Joseph and one of the most visited shrines in the world, capable of holding over 10,000 worshipers. With its dome rising 97 meters, it is second in height only to Saint Peter's Basilica in Rome. During our visit, we will see the original chapel, the Votive Chapel, the crypt, and view relics of Saint André Bessette. Mass will be celebrated at Saint Joseph's Oratory by Fr. Elkin. We will then return to the hotel for time at leisure. Dinner and overnight in Montreal. (B/D)

## Day 3: Wednesday, July 22, 2026 | Kahnawake - Saint Kateri Shrine

After breakfast at the hotel, we will depart for Kahnawake to visit the Saint Francis Xavier Mission and the tomb of Saint Kateri Tekakwitha. This historic

mission houses artifacts dating from the seventeenth to twentieth centuries, including a replica of the World Trade Center created by Mohawk ironworkers and the legendary Deerfield Bell. We will continue with a guided visit to the Saint Kateri Shrine, where Mass will be celebrated by Fr. Elkin. We will then return to the hotel for time at leisure. Dinner and overnight in Montreal. (B/D)

## Day 4: Thursday, July 23, 2026 | Notre-Dame Basilica - Le Bateau-Mouche

After breakfast at the hotel, we will enjoy a guided visit to Notre-Dame Basilica, one of Montréal's most iconic churches, renowned for its richly decorated interior, deep blue vaulted ceiling, intricate wood carvings, and stained-glass windows depicting the religious history of the city. A private Mass will be celebrated here by Fr. Elkin. The remainder of the afternoon will be at leisure. This evening, we will enjoy a dinner river cruise aboard Le Bateau-Mouche, followed by a return to the hotel. Overnight in Montreal. (B/D)

## Day 5: Friday, July 24, 2026 | Montreal - Tulsa

After breakfast at the hotel, we will check out and visit Mary Queen of the World Cathedral. Lunch will be on your own. We will then meet at the hotel and transfer to the airport for our return flight to Tulsa. (B)
