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Canterbury Pilgrimages



Tilma of Guadalupe

Day 1 | Depart for Mexico City

Our pilgrimage begins as we transfer by bus from Tucson to Phoenix Sky Harbor Airport, where we board our flight to Mexico City. Upon arrival, we collect our bags before being greeted by our Canterbury tour manager, who will accompany us by motorcoach to our hotel.

We gather this evening for a

welcome dinner to begin our pilgrimage together. Dinner and overnight in Mexico City.

Day 2 | Shrine of Our Lady of Guadalupe

Today we devote our full day to the Shrine of Our Lady of Guadalupe, Patroness of the Americas. We celebrate Mass in the brilliantly colored modern Basilica, dedicated in 1976, kneeling before the altar displaying the miraculous Tilma, the sackcloth bearing the image of the Blessed Virgin Mary venerated by the faithful for centuries. We also visit the Church of the Hill, the Church of the Well, the Monument of the Offerings, and the Church of the Indians. The afternoon is free to continue exploring the shrine at leisure. Dinner and overnight in Mexico City.

Day 3 | Tlaxcala & Puebla

After breakfast we depart for a full-day excursion outside Mexico City. En route we take in the dramatic sight of two magnificent mountain peaks, one snow-capped and the other an active volcano. We arrive first in Tlaxcala to visit the Shrine of San Miguel del Milagro, where St. Michael the Archangel appeared to Diego Lazaro in 1631. We continue to Puebla to visit St. Dominic's Church and its Chapel of Our Lady of the Rosary, Baroque masterpieces covered in gold leaf, where we celebrate Mass. We also visit the Church of St. Francis of Assisi, home to the incorrupt body of St. Sebastian of Aparicio, and the Biblioteca Palafoxiana, the oldest public library in the Americas,

before free time in Puebla's charming historic streets. Dinner and overnight in Mexico City.

Day 4 | Metropolitan Cathedral & Tenochtitlan

This morning we make our way to downtown Mexico City to visit the Metropolitan Cathedral, the largest cathedral in Latin America. We celebrate Mass and tour its stunning paintings, altarpieces, and statues, including the Tomb of Bishop Zumarraga, the first Bishop of Mexico and a witness to the apparition of Our Lady of Guadalupe. Our guided tour continues with visits to the National Palace, the Zocalo, and the Great Pyramid of Tenochtitlan (Templo Mayor). Dinner and overnight in Mexico City

Day 5 | Tulpetlac & Pyramids of Teotihuacan

After breakfast we visit the church where Blessed Fr. Miguel Pro, S.J. served before his martyrdom. We then travel to Tulpetlac to celebrate Mass at Santa Maria Tulpetlac, the Church of the Fifth Apparition and the site of the miraculous healing of Juan Bernardino. We drink from the miraculous well before journeying to the Pyramids of Teotihuacan, visiting the Temple of Quetzalcoatl and other remarkable structures. We return to the Basilica of Our Lady of Guadalupe before attending an authentic folk performance at the National Palace of Fine Arts and gathering for our farewell dinner. Dinner and overnight in Mexico City.

Day 5 | Return home

With renewed hearts and a deepened love for our Catholic faith, we transfer to Mexico City International Airport for our return flight home to the United States.
